Regulations

International Competition - festival of piano duets and small chamber ensembles for students of small-town and rural music schools

I. Objectives of the competition

- 1. To encourage students and teachers of music schools in small towns and rural areas to focus on chamber ensemble music as a form of collective music making.
- 2. To search and find new talented students.
- 3. To improve students' abilities, creativity, individuality, cooperation and stage culture skills.
- 4. Facilitate the exchange of experience among colleagues from other music schools in Latvia.

II. Venue, time of the competition

- 1. Time of the competition: March 31, 2026.
- 2. The competition will take place in the **White Hall of the Nica's House of Culture** (Bartas street 6, Nica, Nica Parish, Nica County, Latvia, LV3473).

III. Contestants

- 1. The competition takes place in **four** categories of ensembles:
 - Piano duets (trio) <u>please, mention in the application if two pianos are</u> <u>required;</u>
 - 2) Instrumental chamber ensembles with piano;
 - 3) Homogeneous chamber ensembles (no more than 5 members per ensemble)
 - 4) Mixed chamber ensembles (no more than 5 members per ensemble)
- 2. Contest participants students of 2nd 9th grades of professional music education programs, who are evaluated in **three age groups:**

- 1. Group A: 2nd-3rd grade students
- 2. Group B: 4th-5th grade students
- 3. Group C: 6th-9th grade students

<u>In the competition</u>, the age group of the ensemble is determined by the oldest member. Only in the festival age groups are not taken into account and the concertmaster may also be a teacher.

IV. Competition program

- 1. In the competition 2 instrumental compositions of different nature must be played
- 2. Program playback duration:
 - 1. Group A up to 5 minutes
 - 2. Group B up to 7 minutes
 - 3. Group C up to 10 minutes

V. Competition entry fee

- 1. The participation fee in the competition is **25.00 EUR** per ensemble.
- 2. The participation fee must be transferred by **March 23, 2026** to the following account after receipt of the invoice:

VI. Evaluation and awarding

- 1. The competition is evaluated by a three-person jury approved by the director of the Nica School of Music.
- 2. The performance of the ensembles is evaluated in a 25-point system.
- 3. The decision of the jury is final and not subject to appeal.
- 4. All competition and festival participants and teachers receive diploma of gratitude. Contest winners and their teachers receive laureate diplomas.
- 5. Educators will receive certificates for professional development.

VII. Application
