- 1. Students of horn from Latvian and foreign music schools and professional music secondary schools are eligible to participate in the competition.
- 2. Selection criteria:
  - 2.1. completed application form
  - 2.2. paid competition fee
- 3. The competition is organized in **six** age groups:

Group A – born in year **2016** and younger,

Group B – born in years 2014, 2015,

Group C – born in years **2012**, **2013**,

Group **D** – born in years **2010**, **2011**,

Group E – born in years 2008, 2009,

Group F - born in years 2006. un 2007.

- 4. The competition consists of two rounds. Both rounds are public.
- 5. All pieces (App. 1) have to be performed by memory. Participants may not perform the same piece in more than one round.

- 6. The participants draw lots after opening ceremony. The opening ceremony will be held on April 23 at 10:00 in Ergļu Saieta nams. The drawing of lots: Groups A, B and C April 23 at 10:30, Groups D and E and F April 23 at 14:00. The playing order is maintained throughout the competition. If the participant or his representative does not come in time for lot drawing, he will not be admitted to the competition.
- 7. On the day of the competition, before the draw of performance order, each participant must present a valid identity document.
- 8. The competition is judged by an international Jury, in each age group separately, according to common criteria in a 10-point system. All decisions of the Jury are final and not subject to appeal. The marks obtained will not be announced.
- 9. Not more than 10 participants from each group shall be selected by the Jury to participate in the second round of the competition on April 24. Those who do not proceed shall receive an Acknowledgement Script in remembrance of their participation in Juris Jurjāns XXVI International Competition Young Hornist 2026, immediately upon announcement of the results.
- 10. In the 2nd round of the competition, the jury in each age group has the right to award multiple 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, not to award certain places, and to grant diplomas and special prizes.
- 11. Competition applications must be submitted by **March 30, 2026**.

- 13. The competitors receive their prizes and other awards at the Gala Concert where're the first place winners and other participants by Jury choice are performing. The competitors shall be informed about it at the results announcement during the second round and are obliged by this decision to perform at the Concert. If a competitor does not come to take prize, it may be forfeited to the organizers.
- 14. The participants are personally responsible for traveling expenses, boarding and accommodation.
- 15. The previous competition first prize winners may participate only in the next highest age group.
- 16. Processing of personal data. The purpose of personal data processing is to ensure the organization of Juris Jurjāns XXVI International competition "Young Hornist 2026". In accordance with Article 25, Part 1 of the Law on the Processing of Personal Data, when submitting an application, the participant or his legal representative confirms that he is informed and agrees that the participant's name, surname will be published in the printed materials of the competition (competition booklets, diplomas, letters of appreciation), year of birth, music school, class, teacher's name, surname and accompanist's name, surname. If the application for the competition is submitted by a teacher or another representative of an educational institution, by submitting the application they confirm that they have informed the student's parents about the competition regulations and have obtained their consent for the processing of the student's personal data. If the applicant is a minor student, by submitting the application they confirm that they have informed their parents about the
